Dear Mr. Miller,

The Office of the Washington State Auditor has received and completed our response to your public records request sent in via our website, as follows:

***I would like the bulk download of all 'published' Supreme Court of Washington State 'published' opinions in a format such as csv, json, or txt such that these taxpayers funded records from 1887 until 02/062026. This is not a request for records that do not currently exist as wa.gov consistently allows LexisNexis to gain access to these public records funded by the taxpayers. I do not plan to 'sell' these records as information. I plan to make them 'available' on a website to the citizens of WA state using a new search technology. There can be no 'fee' for this, as I've already paid for them in my taxes of over \$20K/year to this state. Thank you. Disclaimer: although you forced me to check the 'fee' box, I do not submit to its authority...as it has no standing. This is 'coarse of performance'...I've already paid for these records.***

In response, our office does not have the record you are seeking. You would need to contact the Washington State Supreme Court directly at [Washington State Courts - Opinions - Home Page](#) to obtain the record you are seeking. Additionally, your local county law library should have a copy of all the Supreme Court Opinions. Since we have no responsive records to fulfil your request with us, we will now consider this closed. SAO does not intend to further address the request, and the PRA's one-year statute of limitations to seek judicial review has started to run as of the date of this letter.
