The Office of the Washington State Auditor has received and completed our response to your public records request sent in via our website, as follows:

***I would like to know the dollar amount allocated yearly for Mental Health-specifically for Asotin County. My understanding is that the funds are directly given to Quality Behavioral Health/Greater Columbia Health for this service. If there are any contracts for this service, I would like that as well. I have contacted Quality Behavioral and Greater Columbia but they both state no contracts between Asotin County exist. They also state the dollar amount is not specific for Asotin County. They just get a large sum for all the counties they service.***
