Dear Mr. Brown, Sr.,

The Office of the Washington State Auditor has completed our response to your public records request sent in via email, as follows:

***Pursuant to the Washington Public Records Act (RCW 42.56), I am requesting the following records:***

- 1. A list of all law enforcement agency audits conducted by the State Auditor since January 1, 2023 that reviewed compliance with RCW 43.101.135 or any other reporting requirements to the Criminal Justice Training Commission (CJTC) regarding officer separation, discipline, or misconduct.***
- 2. Copies of all final audit reports produced as part of these reviews (or direct links to reports if publicly posted).***
- 3. Any available summary or spreadsheet that identifies which agencies have been audited for CJTC reporting compliance and the date each audit report was published.***
- 4. If available, any SAO “planned audit list” or internal tracking document showing which agencies are scheduled for CJTC compliance audits through 2026.***

***This request includes any records, reports, or lists maintained by the SAO that identify which agencies have been audited for CJTC compliance and when those audits were completed.***

In response, we wanted to inform you that the SAO does not have any internal tracking documents for planned certification audits. The auditees are chosen by the CJTC – not the SAO.

The entities we have audited for compliance with RCW 43.101.135 are:

- Redmond Police Department – Pilot (attached report)

- Marysville Police Department – Pilot (attached report)
- Renton Police Department – Published [report](#) on website
- Des Moines Police Department – Published [report](#) on website
- Kitsap County Sheriff's Office – In progress (available on website once released)
- Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife – In progress (available on website once released)

In response, we have attached all the responsive records found to fulfill your request with us. We will now consider this closed. SAO does not intend to further address the request, and the PRA's one-year statute of limitations to seek judicial review has started to run as of the date of this letter.
