The Office of the Washington State Auditor has completed our response to your public records request sent in via email, as follows:

This request is being input on behalf of Matt McCord by Assistant Director Jim Brownell. Mr. McCord is a Sr. Investigator at DSHS and wants copies of our work papers for the following TeamMate project: S1DCYF&DSHS-FD23. There are also related documents in the fraud database under F-23-364. The reason I am submitting this as a PRR is because the file contains records from both DSHS and DCYF. I will forward the original email to the PRR email address for your records. I am an investigator with DSHS HRD and was just assigned a case about which your office has recently concluded an audit, namely, Daniel Kresse. He is alleged to have been double dipping while employed with DSHS and DCYF. I am hoping to be able to obtain a copy of the SAO audit your agency completed to be included as part of my investigative efforts. Please advise how best to accomplish this. Do you need a special request? Is there an agency sharing agreement? Etc.?

In response, we have attached all the responsive records found to fulfill your request with us, as well as the redaction codes used. We will now consider this closed. SAO does not intend to further address the request, and the PRA's one-year statute of limitations to seek judicial review has started to run as of the date of this letter.
