Dear Ms. Walter,

The Office of the Washington State Auditor has received and completed our response to your public records request sent in via our website, as follows:

***I retired from Everett School District in 2019. Friends of mine retired 2 or more years earlier than I did. We got a 1095-C from the district this year showing we had insurance coverage by our employer which we did not. I contacted Gayla Jennings in Payroll and she said this year the HCA (Washington State Health Care Authority) told them to send these out to retired staff. HCA says they did not tell them to do it. I believe Gayla Jennings and she said they were not the only district told to do it. The district does not cover our premiums. I object to them taking a tax credit for us that are retired. PEBB has not issued our 1095-B to retired teachers, yet, which is what retired teachers should get being we are not covered or employed anymore. In order to have Medicare Part B, we all had to show we were no longer covered by our employer. I have called PEBB, HCA, Veba, Office of Financial Management, and the State Insurance Commissioner's Office. We would all like to know why the districts in the state used us for their submittal to the IRS as being covered and receiving any tax credit for it.***

Unfortunately this is not a public records request for an identifiable record. This is a request for information that our office would not have answers for. Please let us know if you have any questions, concerns or issues regarding this request. We will now consider this closed.
