Hello Mary,

Today two reporters asked for essentially the same data from our newest performance [audit of homelessness services contracting](#). Wanted to loop you in, expecting you will want to track these as records requests.

We looked at services provided by contractors, and determined whether contractors were hitting their agreed-upon targets or were 'underperforming.' We do not name the contractors or identify what specific services were underperforming in the report. An example from the report is, *"For the 10 underperforming programs we examined, the county asked providers why programs were underperforming, but only took corrective action to address poor performance for one program."*

Anna Patrick of the Seattle Times requested the names of the contracted service providers we reviewed, which service areas we reviewed and which areas we identified as underperforming. She most wants that information for the City of Seattle, but said she would like all of that data. Her email is : apatrick@seattletimes.com

Jerry Cornfield of the Everett Herald requested that information for Snohomish County. And a copy of the Department of Commerce guidelines with which governments were to comply, as referenced in the report. His email is jcornfield@heraldnet.com.
